Last week’s Brain Teaser! 20 hens, housed in 5 coops, will hatch 45 eggs in 9 days. How long will it take 30 hens, housed in 7 coops, to hatch 60 eggs?

Answer: 8 days. $20 \times 9 = 180$ days for 45 eggs; 4 days per egg. 60 eggs require 240 days. $240 \div 30 = 8$ days. The number of coops is irrelevant
