COVID 19 Update 5 – March 23, 2020

On March 23, 2020 Governor Charlie Baker issued COVID-19 Order No. 13. The Governor has placed further restrictions and issued additional recommendations to combat the Coronavirus Pandemic.

The Governor has temporarily closed all Non Essential Businesses and Services. Brookhaven, and other Continuing Care Facilities have been classified as Essential Services and will remain open and fully functional. The order also urges “all residents of the Commonwealth to limit activities outside of the home and to practice social distancing at all times.” The recommendation is even stronger for citizens over the age of 70.

Therefore, Brookhaven is following these suggestions and we are restricting all visitors to the entire campus from March 24, 2020 to April 7, 2020. We are also making the strongest recommendation possible that all residents refrain from leaving the campus, please feel free to enjoy walking the campus, or sitting on one of our benches, but remain on campus.

We continue to ask residents to follow social distancing guidance while at Brookhaven. Keep 6 feet of separation between you and others. This is especially important when picking up your meals. Please come down at your scheduled time for meals, coming down early or late causes an unsafe bunching situation. Please take advantage of the Country Store and the extended hours. Please follow the limit on size of groups posted in each venue.
