Brookhaven at Lexington COVID-19 Update 20 – June 16, 2020

Our number of positive cases remains unchanged at two. The remaining two Residents continue to do well and continue on their way to a full recovery. We have not had any new cases and we all need to work together to keep the virus off the campus. Residents and Staff will be asked to continue to practice social distancing and wear their masks when in public. We continue to encourage Residents to stay on the Brookhaven Campus as we still believe that it is “Safer at Brookhaven.”

Along with the rest of the state, Brookhaven is slowly and gradually restarting services. As we announced last week we now have our Podiatrists back in the building. The newspapers are back at your doors. This week we will start housekeeping and maintenance in units. Next week we will open the Salon at 1010. As with all of the previously mentioned services we will ensure that each is performed with all of the protocols in place to provide a safe environment.

This past week we have been able to allow for outside visits for the entire community. Babson and Gardenview visits are scheduled and monitored by a trained member of our Staff. We ask that all visitors follow social distancing guidelines and wear masks and wash hands before and after a visit.

We are confident that we can rely on the COVID-19 data provided by the state. Massachusetts has been a leader in providing fact based data regarding testing, cases, and hospital utilization. All of the metrics that the state is watching are trending in the right direction. We will continue to look at what else is safe to open later in the summer. It is extremely important that Brookhaven follow behind what the state is opening for the general public.

Each week we are pleased to see the new plants and trees on the campus. I would encourage everyone that is able to walk outside to explore the campus. We have the benefit of being situated on over 30 acres of land surrounded by conservation and recreation restricted land. As a reminder always wear bug spray when walking off the marked paths.
